

# Humane Society of South Mississippi Volunteer Release Agreement And Covenant Not to Sue

This waiver in short states that you as a volunteer agree and understand that you will be working around pets and situations that could result in injury or illness, and that you are responsible for attaining your own insurance to cover any and all expenses that might occur.

I, the undersigned, do hereby agree to release the Humane Society of South Mississippi (further to be known as HSSM) from all liability. I will not hold HSSM liable for any damage, illness or injury sustained during volunteer work. I, the undersigned, will never institute any action or suit at law or in equity against HSSM, nor institute, prosecute or in any way aid, assist, or participate, directly or indirectly, in the institution or prosecution of any claim, demand, action or cause of action for damages, costs, loss of service, expenses, or compensation for or on account of any damage, loss or injury either to person or property, or both, whether developed or undeveloped, resulting or to result, known or unknown, past, present, or future, arising out of the condition or operation of HSSM and its facilities (including but not limited to any damage, loss or injury either to person or property, or both, resulting from contact with or the actions or conduct of any animal located at or in the custody or control of or in releases, demises, and discharges HSSM). The undersigned volunteer further hereby releases, demises, and discharges HSSM and covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold HSSM harmless of and from demands, damages, suits, costs or expenses said volunteer's had or may have for any reason or which may occur or arise by reason of volunteer's association, activity or work now, heretofore or hereafter at or with HSSM.
